

PSLIST gives bogus message to install EXCTRLST in WINDOWS 7

Being a big fan and constant user of the Sysinternals pstools/systemals suite of command line tools I was surprised when pslist.exe suddenly gave this message for every pc I tried to access including my own:

```
c:\pslist \\anypcitrried
```

```
pslist v1.29 - Sysinternals PsList  
Copyright (C) 2000-2009 Mark Russinovich  
Sysinternals
```

```
Processor performance object not found on KYLL4RT2CS1  
Try running Exctrlst from microsoft.com to repair the performance counters.
```

I ran perfmon and discovered it was unable to load various performance counters as well.

Naturally I followed the instructions re EXCTRLST, but I kept getting the same message from both apps.

Solution was to run:

```
c:\lodctr /r
```

Pslist working now and perfmon too.

Posting here because a similar problem was resolved here, but not exactly the same.
Not so much a question as a posted resolution someone might find.
